### Spring 2025

The next Czech & English Meets event, organized by the Department of Languages in cooperation with IFMSA CZ HK and OPR, took place on Thursday, March 6, 2025. Since the event is traditionally very popular among students and this year marks the 80th anniversary of our faculty, the capacity was increased. As a result, a total of 100 students from both Czech and English study programs attended. Due to the large number of participants, the event was held in the Theoretical Department Building on Šimkova Street.





As the event aims to bring both student communities closer together, it began at 5:30 PM with an informal "icebreaker" discussion in small mixed groups, where students had the chance to introduce themselves. Afterwards, they split into three groups and continued in classrooms with a quiz competition that included questions about our faculty, medical studies, and the Czech Republic.
