



Our faculty defended the Dean's Cup this year as well, because it had more participants in the race than FaF UK.

Although he can't see much and his eyesight is impaired, he is a very smart little boy who, despite his disability, is not afraid of new challenges and bravely fights everything. His parents will use the proceeds from the fundraising run to purchase contrast aids to develop motor skills and stimulate vision, as well as occupational therapy, which is not covered by health insurance.

On Wednesday, April 20, 2022, the 5th annual Run for Life Foundation Run took place. The travelling cup therefore remains with our faculty.
