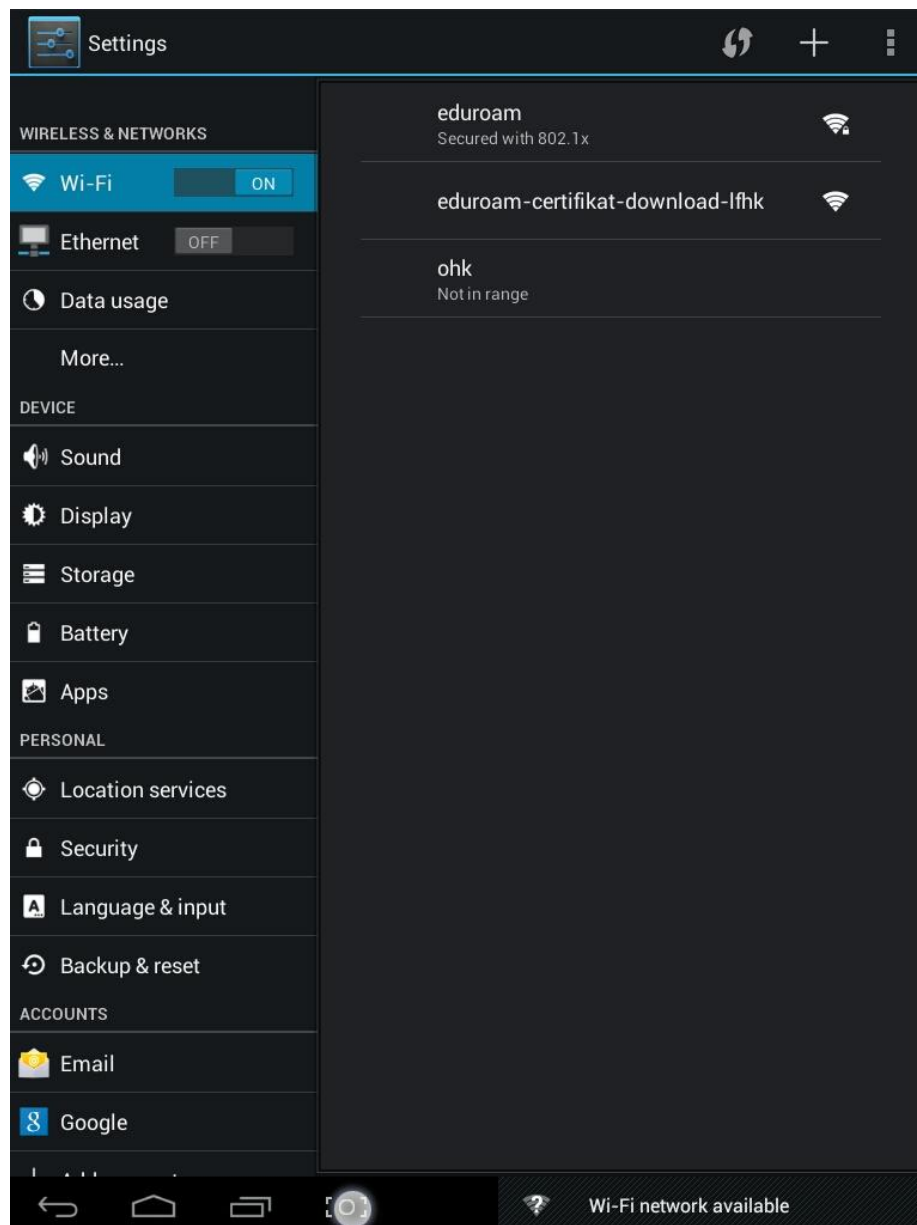


How to connect to the eduroam on Android

This is simplified guide to set connection without verifying server certificate. Different versions of Android may vary, so guide may not be accurate and 100% operational.

This guide has been tested on Android 4.1.

- 1) To use the eduroam network, first you have to create an eduroam password. You can create an eduroam password in CAS UK system, address <https://ldap.cuni.cz>. User guide for password creation is at <https://www.lfhk.cuni.cz/Information-Systems/Eduroam>. Your username for eduroam network is YourPersonalNumber@cuni.cz (for example 12345678@cuni.cz). Your personal number is on your ISIC card under your photo.
- 2) Go to the Menu of Android and select **Settings**.
- 3) Select **Wi-Fi** and switch it On.



4) Tap on **eduroam** .

5) Fill in the details:

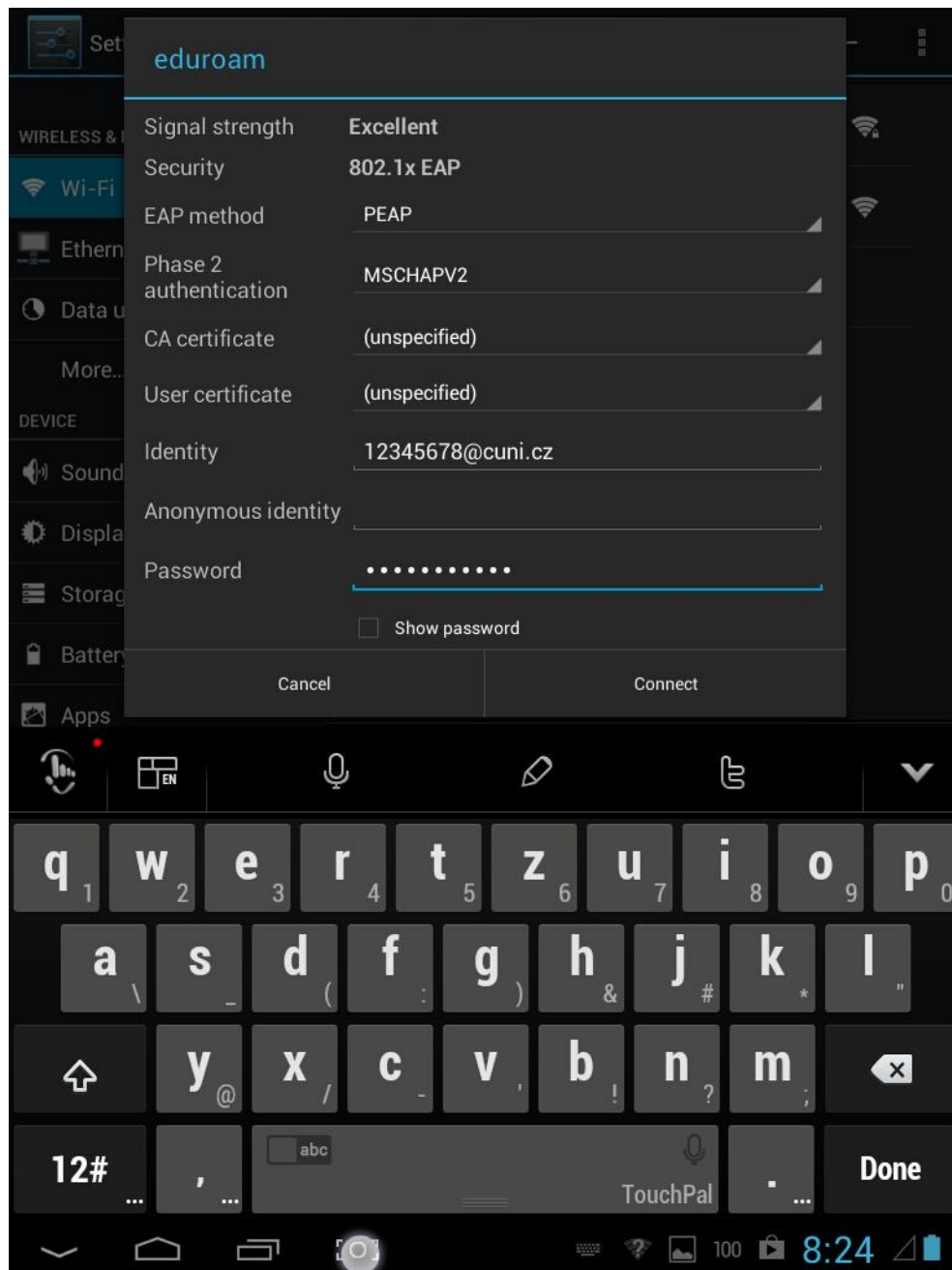
EAP method: PEAP

Phase 2 authentication: MSCHAPV2

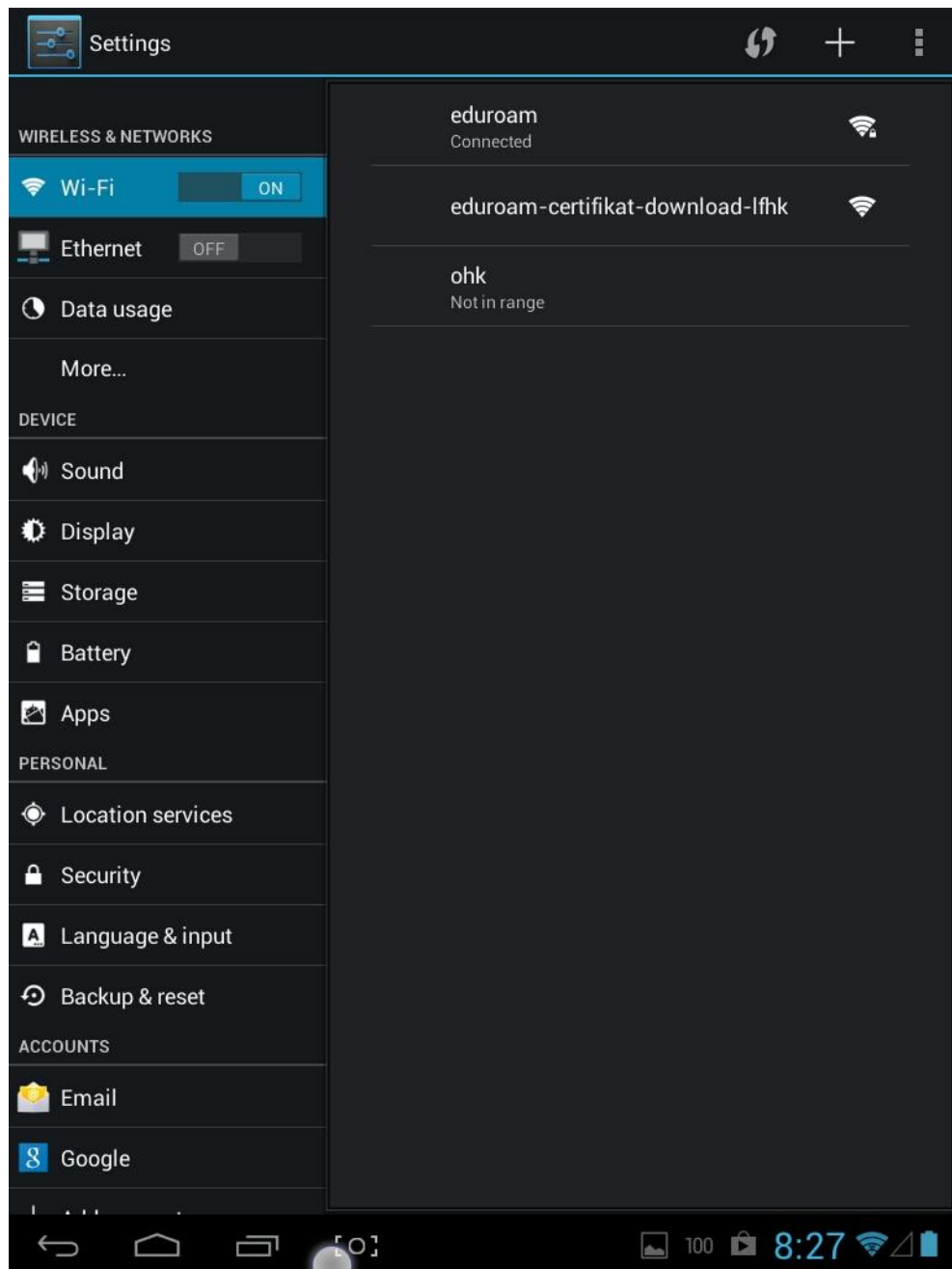
Identity: **YourPersonalNumber@cuni.cz** (for example
12345678@cuni.cz)

Anonymous identity: keep blank

Wireless password: your_eduroam_password maked in CAS



- 6) After completing of the data tap on **Connect**. If everything is correct your Android is connected to eduroam.
